Stalls: There will be plenty of stalls available - \$40 per stall for the weekend. Shavings are not provided but available for sale. No horses can be tied at your trailer or in pens. Let Ms Leisa know the total number of stalls you will need when you call in on Monday, Oct. 19th. You can share a feed or tack stall with other people. Just let her know how many stalls and who your stalls need to be next to. The stalls are numbered and there will be a list of names and stall numbers on the end of the barn. **DO NOT PUT YOUR HORSE IN A STALL NOT ASSIGNED TO YOU.** If you have a problem with your stall, you will need to see Mr. Danny Dudley upon arrival. He will be handling the stalls again this year. You will pay for your stalls at sign-in with your fees. You can write one check for stalls and fees.

Hook-ups: Contact the Fair Grounds for your hook-ups 478-988-6557. Hook-ups are \$25 per night. No generators are allowed. This is an Agricenter rule. Admittance to the fairgrounds will begin on Friday at noon – not before.

Grand Entry: **Friday – Pink night, Saturday – State Choice, Sunday: Red, White & Blue.** There is a \$250 Spirit Award this year for the state having the most spirit.

Dress Code: Contestants must be in full dress code if you come to Reeves arena. Back numbers at all times from the time you arrive on the grounds, until you leave the grounds.
