The only form you will bring to me at the first rodeo will be the signed parent waiver that is required at every rodeo. If these forms are not completed and uploaded, you will not be able to compete. - _____ Conduct, Behavior, and Social Media Agreement (Found on GHSRA website)
- _____ Waiver of Liability (Found on GHSRA website) must bring this form to every rodeo

If you have full custody or a parent is deceased it must be written on the forms that requires both parent's signatures and contestant's signature. This is a NHSRA rule and requirement for membership to be completed.
